In June 2023, we hosted our annual Advocacy Summit in Washington, D.C.
As part of the Summit, we held a Latino consultation, a Pan-African
convening, and a Hill Day to educate and inform advocates about
policies that address hunger and poverty. On Lobby Day following the
summit, Bread anti-hunger advocates met with 171 members of Congress
from 34 states and 104 congressional districts to advocate for

hunger-centric laws and policies in the farm bill that would move our nation and world closer to the end of hunger. Our collective voice echoed through the halls of Congress.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4c, Program Service Accomplishments: The U.S. Farm Bill was a central part of our advocacy efforts in 2023. The Farm Bill sets national policies for nutrition, agriculture, conservation, and forestry. This legislation provides nutrition assistance to millions of Americans through programs such as SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program). Bread for the World advocated for a fair, equitable, and sustainable farm bill in 2023 when the bill was scheduled to be reauthorized. Bread advocated for enhancements to global maternal and child nutrition through the Food for Peace and McGovern-Dole Food for Education programs. We organized our members and our government relations staff to protect Food for Peace funding, which is used for local procurement of foods, food vouchers, and cash assistance. In November 2023, Congress successfully passed a one-year extension of the 2018 Farm Bill. An extension that amounts to "more of the same" may not seem like victory, but this came in a year when most of the Bread-supported programs in the farm bill were threatened with drastic cuts during the appropriations negotiations process. Bread's network prevented MORE THAN \$1.2 Billion from being cut from Food for Peace, which in 2022 reached 53 million people in 21 countries with critical food and nutrition aid.

Also included in the omnibus legislation is the House's reauthorization of the Healthy Meals, Healthy Kids Act, which Bread supported. It seeks to increase access to free meals for children in high-poverty schools

and to increase nutrition standards in those meals. Passage of the Keep

Kids Fed Act will ensure free summer meals for about 30 million kids in

America, regardless of income. The bill included nearly \$3 billion to

extend all pandemic school meal waivers through the summer, as well as

supply chain flexibilities and increased federal reimbursements through
the 2022-23 school year.

During and after last year's United Nations Climate Change Conference

(COP), following Bread for the World's October Climate and Hunger

Convocation in Nairobi, Kenya, Bread for the World advocated with

high-level government officials for continued action on climate. We

expressed gratitude to the U.S. government for their involvement in the

intersection between climate change, food security, and agriculture at

COP's first ever Food Systems Pavilion. We also applauded the United

States' doubling its pledge to the Adaptation Fund to \$100 billion.

Bread for the World was proud to support the work of the PREPARE

initiative, through which the United States has instituted a

whole-of-government approach to addressing climate change and food

insecurity.

The National Strategy that came out of the White House Conference on

Hunger, Nutrition, and Health is a long-term vision for addressing

hunger in America. It contains many policies that Bread supports and
